ABOUT THE EVENT: This is a community fall arts & culture event. Judging to take place downtown (approx 25 N. Main St.) at Durgin Green, Wolfeboro, NH by 2:00pm. The event includes completed creative pumpkins and music/entertainment.

ELIGIBILITY: All individuals are welcome to participate. Children, teens and adults will be judged in their own age/ability categories. You create your pumpkin at home and bring it to the judging stand or children may paint on site for an add'l \$5.

REGISTRATION: Each participant is to fill in the Registration form with the non-refundable \$5 fee. This form will be available on our website: www.wolfeboroarts.org to download and at the final judging location at Durgin Green from 10am - 2pm. Children under 12yrs must have a parent sign their form. This form must be completed/turned in with the \$5 fee when delivering your pumpkin for display.

EVENT TIMELINE:

10am - 2pm - Check in
2:00pm - Pumpkin Judging begins (no late entries permitted)
2:30pm - Judges Award Prizes for Pumpkins
3pm - Viewing End time

PRIZES:

Award winners must be present to claim their prize, or someone must be there on your behalf. Prizes: Children under 12yrs / Teens / Adults. A first, second, and third prize ribbon is awarded in each category. People's Choice prize chosen by public vote.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The \$5 Registration fee is non-refundable and must be paid to participate with the completed Registration form.
- Only one pumpkin creation is permitted per individual.
- The contest committee, or press may take photos of your work for publicity.
- Please be respectful of others' works of art and do not harm, impede or otherwise destroy their creations.
- This is a family event. Artwork containing nudity, profanity, or content deemed inappropriate by the contest committee will be removed and the artist disqualified.
